



Australian Sports Pony Registry Inc. 'Overheight'

An appendix listing to the ASPR Stud Book
for mares and stallions over 148 cms without shoes—149 cms with shoes

Mares and stallions that measure over the ASPR height maximum of 148 cms (without shoes—149 cms with shoes) may be eligible for registration in the 'Overheight Appendix'.

These horses provide pony breeders with the opportunity to breed up to height ponies and to utilise bloodlines not available amongst existing pony breeds.

Any pony stallion or mare that has previously been assessed and registered with the ASPR and then grows over the height maximum will be automatically transferred to the overheight appendix. Geldings that grow over the height maximum will be de-registered.

Conditions of Entry to the ASPR "Overheight Appendix"

- Mares and stallions eligible only and must measure over 148 cm without shoes - 149 cms with shoes
- Any breed or colour is accepted
- Overheight Appendix horses must be a minimum of three years of age (as at 1st August preceding application)
- Horse must be assessed by the ASPR/ACE Group Assessors **or** already have been assessed by the ACE Group Assessors **or** by a stud book or registry recognised by the ASPR
 - 70% and under 80% - OH First Premium
 - 80% and above – OH Premier
 - If all 4 phases (conformation/in hand, at liberty, ridden and jumping) are completed a * rating will be applied.
- Owners of 'Overheight Appendix' mares and stallions must become members of the ASPR Inc.
- Approved application must be completed by the owner and must be accompanied by the **Overheight Appendix Fee of \$40.**
- Owners of stallions and mares that have an existing assessment score with the ACE Group (as above) and are already registered with the ACE Group, are required to provide a copy of the assessment score sheet to the ASPR
- Owners of stallions and mares that do not have an existing assessment score and wish to be approved must be booked into an ASPR/ACE Assessment Tour. Microchipping is optional.
- Owners of stallions and mares that have already been assessed/licenses by a stud book or registry recognised by the ASPR must provide proof of assessment and relevant score sheets.
- Overheight Appendix horses are NOT eligible to compete as a registered ASPR pony in competitions, High Points or ROM Awards.
- Owners of Overheight Appendix stallions are required to purchase ASPR service certificates - apply to the Federal Office
- Any progeny born on or after 1st August, 2008 must supply an ASPR service certificate in order to be eligible for assessment.

Breeding Licenses for 'Overheight Appendix' stallions will be issued providing the stallion produces 6 progeny that are fully adult registered and graded as First Premium or Premier (ie: 70% and above) with the ASPR and that those 6 progeny remain at 148 cm or under. In order to be eligible to be counted within the 6 progeny, the pony must complete the in hand, at liberty and under saddle phases of the assessment. Any female or entire progeny registered that grows over height is not eligible for listing within the 6 progeny, and must be de-registered and is then eligible to be added to the 'Overheight Appendix' listing (geldings ineligible).
